Fire

In the event of a fire, immediate response is critical in order to minimize any damage. And knowing whom to call is the crucial first step. The best guidance we have been able to receive is that two calls should be made immediately when anyone notices or suspects a fire: immediately place calls to both the Long Beach Fire Department and to “911.” If either number puts you on hold, get to the other number immediately. Don’t hesitate a moment. Timing makes all the difference.
